## Fly Fishing

More than 50 acres of ponds, lakes, and streams are woven throughout the community for the fishing enjoyment of residents and guests. Teton Springs engaged the services of Biota Research and Consulting to design waterways that incorporate rock-lined fish ladders to create the ideal habitat for trout spawning. Spend the afternoon fishing for Yellowstone Cutthroats just outside your back door at Teton Springs!

Eastern Idaho is home to notable rivers and trout streams, known around the world by many experienced anglers.

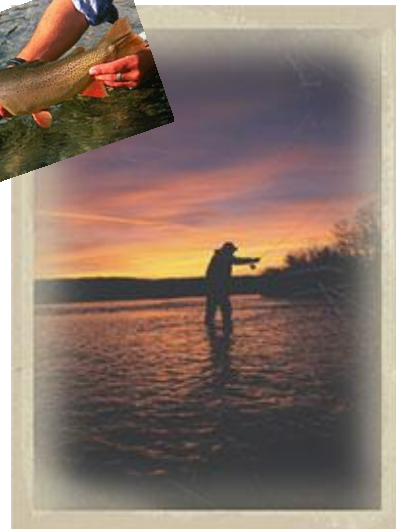
**Teton River** is one of the best kept secrets among anglers. It flows through the middle of the valley and is home to three types of trout: native Cutthroat, the Rainbow, and the Brook Trout.

**Henry's Fork of the Snake River**, located in Eastern Idaho, is one of the most famous trout streams in the United States. Its prolific hatches and large rainbows make it a tremendous dry fly fishery. The river flows for approximately 150 miles and within its journey passes some of the more classic dry fly water in the United States. Gently flowing ranch land, quality pocket water, and spring creek like sections make up much of this tremendous fishery.

**South Fork of the Snake River** in Swan Valley Idaho is the section of the Snake that begins after the Palisades Reservoir. Featuring incredible fishing for Yellowstone Cutthroat, Rainbows and Brown Trout, it is most famed for multiple hatches and great dry fly fishing in the riffles.

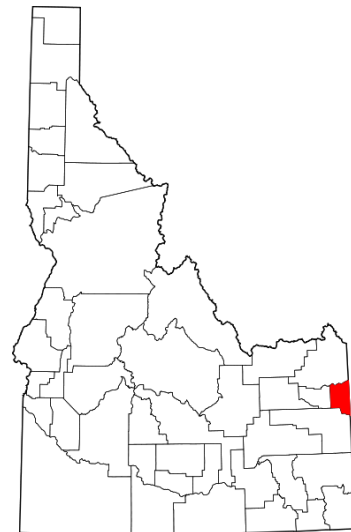
